## **Special Education Transportation Protocols at Program Sites**

- 1. School bus sign up and flashing as students embark and disembark vehicle.
- 2. Maximum of 8 passengers, not including driver.
- 3. Company name and address displayed on vehicle.
- 4. Monitors sit in back with students.
- 5. All passengers must wear seatbelts.
- 6. Engine shut off when students embark and disembark, only exception if engine is needed to run wheelchair lift.
- 7. Drivers/monitors are not required by law to assist students or equipment on or off the vehicle; this is a contract stipulation between the sending school and the vendor or stated in the IEP.
- 8. Drivers/monitors are NOT required to seatbelt or fasten car seats; this is a contract stipulation between the sending school and the vendor.
- 9. Drivers/monitors responsible for operating wheel chair lift, loading and unloading students, fastening tie downs.
- 10. All wheelchairs must have seatbelts in the chair, responsibility of parent and staff to make sure fastened
- 11. Wheelchair lift must be equipped with a safety belt or gate lift in up position when students are on the lift.
- 12. No smoking permitted on the vehicle at any time.
- 13. No eating or drinking allowed on vehicle.
- 14. Taxi or livery companies may provide transportation on an emergency basis, not to exceed five days.
